This policy update reflects recent changes in Idaho law, including Senate Bill 1118, which raises the dollar thresholds for public works, services, and personal property procurement. These legislative updates allow simplified purchasing processes to be used for higher-cost projects than before. All revisions have been incorporated into the policy to keep RISE Charter School in full compliance with state requirements. The Board is asked to review and consider approval of the updated policy as presented.

7405P

This policy has been updated to reflect new requirements in Idaho law, particularly the changes made by Senate Bill 1118. The bill increases the dollar thresholds that determine which procurement procedures schools must follow when purchasing goods, services, and public works construction.

As a result, the policy now:

- Raises the cost ranges for when RISE must seek three bids, use a sealed bid process, or follow other formal procurement steps.
- Updates the public works project thresholds (e.g., moving the \$50,000–\$200,000 range to \$100,000–\$250,000).
- **Raises the thresholds** for purchasing personal property or services (e.g., moving the \$50,000–\$100,000 range to \$100,000–\$250,000).
- Makes technical and procedural adjustments so the policy aligns with the new state requirements.

No substantive processes were added or removed—only the dollar amounts and related procedural references were updated to keep RISE Charter School in full compliance with Idaho law.
