### High School Graduation Course and Credit Requirements

<b>Core Credit</b>	<b>33 Credits Required</b>	Courses and credit available as of current school year (+ required by ISDE)
<b>Language Arts</b>	<b>9</b>	English 9 (2 credits)+ English 10 (2 credits)+ English 11 (2 credits)+ English 12 (2 credits)+ Speech (1 Credit)+
<b>Mathematics</b>	<b>6</b>	Algebra I (2 credits)+ Geometry (2 credits)+ Algebra II (2 credits) Modeling and Statistical Reasoning (2 credits)
<b>Science</b>	<b>6</b>	The Living Earth (2 credits) Physics in the Universe (2 credits) Chemistry in the Earth System (2 credits) Environmental Science (2 credits)
<b>Social Studies</b>	<b>7</b>	Modern World I (2 credits) Modern World II (2 credits) US History (2 credits)+ AP US History (2 credits) AP Government (2 credits)+ Economics (1 credit)+ Civics (1 credit)
<b>Humanities</b>	<b>2</b>	May include visual arts, music, theatre, dance, or world language aligned to Idaho content standards for those subjects+
<b>Physical Education</b>	<b>2</b>	Physical Education (1 credit) PE elective (1 credit)
<b>Health</b>	<b>1</b>	Health (1 credit)+

<b>Year-Long Self-Directed Projects</b>	<b>13 Credits Required</b>	May include research, planning, proposal, internship, project completion, presentation, etc.
<b>9<sup>th</sup> grade</b>	<b>1</b>	50 hours
<b>10<sup>th</sup> grade</b>	<b>2</b>	100 hours
<b>11<sup>th</sup> grade</b>	<b>4</b>	200 hours
<b>12<sup>th</sup> grade</b>	<b>6</b>	300 hours

<b>General Electives</b>	<b>6 Credits Required</b>	Credits not associated with core credit or year-long projects.
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<b>Additional Information</b>	
<b>Middle School Credits</b>	A student will have met the high school content and credit requirement for any required high school course if: The student completes such course with a grade C or higher before entering 9th grade; course meets the same content standards that are required for high school and course is taught by a properly certified teacher.*
<b>Civics Test</b>	All secondary students must demonstrate that they have met the state civics and government standard by the successfully completing the civics test or alternate path. Typically taken in required Government course.
<b>College Entrance Exam</b>	Students must take either the ACT or SAT exam before the end of the student's 11th grade.*
<b>Self-Directed Projects</b>	Exemption and/or accommodation if student transfers to RISE, has an IEP or 504, etc. on a case-by-case basis.
<b>Internships and Work Experience</b>	Count toward project credit, if applicable. General elective credit on a case-by-case basis.
<b>Dual Enrollment/Credit</b>	AP courses, IDLA, and courses offered through College of Southern Idaho encouraged as part of Advanced Opportunities.
<b>12<sup>th</sup> Grade Math</b>	One math course must be taken during senior year.
<b>Lab-based Science</b>	Four science credits must be lab-based.
