



RISE Charter School—Grades 7-10 Certified Science Teacher

RISE Charter School is an innovative, new school to the rural community of Kimberly, Idaho. This school was developed to offer a unique educational model that promotes critical thinking through project-based learning. RISE is implementing the Summit curriculum to achieve this goal. This comprehensive curriculum prepares students to not only meet the academic challenges of the world, but also focuses on the social, emotional and cognitive development of students.

RISE is seeking a motivated individual who is hoping to make a significant, positive impact in the lives of young people and teach Science full-time to grades 7-10. This candidate will need to be skilled in explaining scientific concepts to students. A teaching certificate with endorsements in Biology, Natural Science, Geology or Earth and Space Science will be ideal, but a Bachelor of Science degree in any related field will be considered.

The successful candidate will need to participate in the critical “on-boarding” work to learn the curriculum including after school online trainings. This candidate will supplement the Summit curriculum with projects, modeling, and instruction that enables students to master the essential science skills for each grade level. We expect the Summit Platform to be implemented with fidelity, but this platform also allows you the freedom to add or subtract elements from the unit that enhance the instruction. In addition to teaching Science courses, you will teach one elective course and may choose to teach an additional elective course- of your choosing.

A key ingredient of the Summit curriculum is the one-on-one mentoring of students. You will be expected to meet with each of your assigned students at least twice monthly to review their personal and academic goals, offer assistance and counsel your mentees. You will have the unique opportunity to work together with our small team of teachers to help design the culture of this school. We teach our students “16 Habits of Success” and expect our educators to model these same characteristics. Learning from other teachers is a key to success, so RISE educators also have time built into the week for professional collaboration with our team of teachers.

We value exceptional educators at RISE so salary will be based on the Idaho State Department of Education Teacher Salary schedule with additional stipends. You will also be eligible for full-time healthcare benefits and PERSI retirement.
