Chronic Behavior Violation Policy

Purpose This policy establishes clear guidelines for addressing minor and major behavior violations, ensuring a structured and consistent approach to student discipline in alignment with RISE Charter School's policies.

Minor Violations Minor violations, such as tardiness or dress code infractions, follow a progressive discipline system:

- **3 Minor Violations:** The student will serve a lunch detention and complete a behavior reflection form.
- **6 Minor Violations:** The student will receive an appropriate consequence.
- Accumulating six minor reflections will result in one major reflection.

Less than 3 Major Violations: The student will receive a consequence appropriate to the major behavior, which may include suspension or other corrective actions as outlined in Policy 3330 and Policy 3340.

Chronic or Repeated Violations

- **3 Major Behavior Violations or a Combination of Major and Minor Violations:** The student will be assigned an In-School Suspension (ISS) for the remainder of the day and may face a possible Out-of-School Suspension (OSS).
- **Each Additional Major Behavior Violation:** Further disciplinary action will be taken, including a second ISS and the possibility of a one-to-three-day OSS.

10 or More Behavior Violations: Students accumulating ten or more behavior referrals, whether major or a combination of minor and major violations, may face more severe consequences, as Determined by Administration. These consequences may include:

- **Limited Participation / Loss of Participation** in School Events and Activities
- **Remote Learning Placement:** The student may be required to complete coursework remotely for a designated period.
- **Extended Out-of-School Suspension (OSS):** The student may face an extended suspension based on the severity of offenses.
- **Expulsion Hearing:** A formal review may be initiated to determine if expulsion is necessary, in accordance with Policy 3330—Student Discipline.

Minor reflections	6 reflections	Teacher or Office	Student receives consequence that fits the behavior
6 minor reflections	1 Major reflections	Teacher or Office	Student receives consequence that fits the behavior
Major reflections	Less than 3 Major reflections	Office	Student receives consequence that fits the behavior
Major Behavior	3 Major reflections or Combination of Major/ Minor reflections	Teacher or Office	In-school suspension remainder of day; possible out of school suspension
Additional Major reflections	Each additional Major reflections results in a suspension	Office	2 nd ISS, possible 1-3 days OSS suspension
Chronic & Major Behavior	10 or more reflections	Teacher or Office	Remote learning, extended OSS, Expulsion hearing
Policy Renewal Behavior records reset at the beginning of each school year. However, expulsion consequences remain in place as determined by Policy 3330—Student Discipline.
